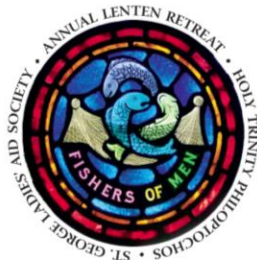
Fr. Joseph Gingrich



Rev. Fr. Joseph Gingrich was born and raised in Cincinnati, Ohio. He graduated from the Greater Cincinnati Culinary Arts Academy in 1993, and did continuing education work at the Culinary Institute of America. He was baptized in 2001 and is a graduate of the Ecumenical Patriarchate's Christ the Saviour Seminary with a Bachelor of Theology. He was ordained a priest in 2010. He served as pastor of St. George Church in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, from 2015, and he has been Pastor Annunciation Church in Dayton, Ohio, since the beginning of 2017.

In addition to parish work Fr. Joseph has been involved in interfaith work and social ministry to the poor. Most recently he did this in the lower east side of Manhattan.
