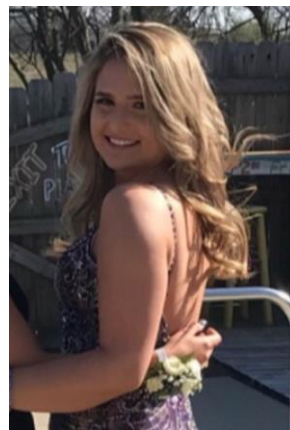
Claire Azar

Jasmine Egly

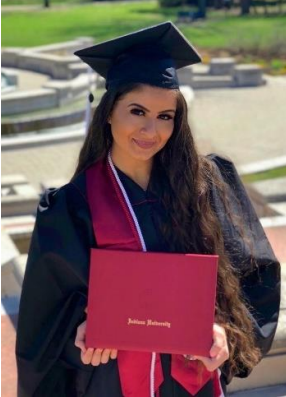

Grace Dickinson

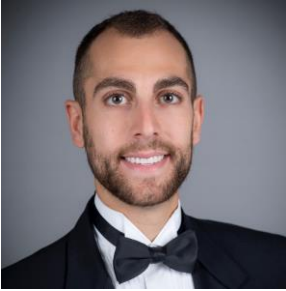
