
PARISH THANKSGIVING DINNER SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 11


Canned and Non-perishable Food for Our Food Pantry

As part of our parish participation in the Archdiocese-wide World Food Day program, we ask you to bring in canned goods and other non-perishable items. You can place them on the table in the main Lobby.

Please check the expiration date on the items you purchase and try to bring items whose expiration date is in late 2019 or after. PLEASE DO NOT BRING EXPIRED ITEMS.

- **November 4** Spaghetti, pastas: dry or canned; spaghetti sauce, bread, salt, pepper, cooking oil
- **November 11** Small boxes of cold cereal, oatmeal, non-fat dried milk, Juice boxes

We report the total poundage received to the Archdiocese, but we keep the items for our own food pantry to help those in need (including parishioners).


