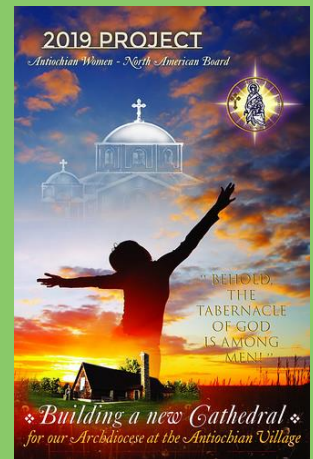
JOIN US FOR A "SOUPER" SUNDAY AND FELLOWSHIP AFTER LITURGY

We all know not to park in a designated handicapped spot unless we have a special license plate or placard, but we can do more:

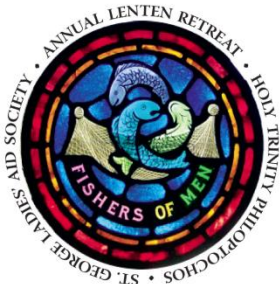
